

St. Bridget 2008 Vegas Night
Texas Hold-Em Tournament Rules

1. 80 Seats
2. \$65.00 Entry Fee
3. Only persons with prepaid reservations will be guaranteed a seat.
4. Open unreserved seats will be filled on a first come-first served basis.
5. Players begin with 2-\$1,000, 2-\$500 chips, 6-\$100 chips and 8-\$50 chips for a total of \$4,000.
- 6. No re-buys or add-ons**
7. Posted pay-outs dependent on full 80 person event. If fewer players participate, pay-outs will be adjusted accordingly.
8. The dealer position at each table will be determined by the first Ace dealt
9. As seat positions open, players will move as instructed by the tournament director to balance the tables
10. Blinds begin at \$50 and \$100 and will increase every 20 minutes pursuant to the schedule
11. In the event of 3 or more all-ins at the final table, the losing player with more money in the pot beats the other player
12. Cards must remain above the table during all games
13. When folding, no one may reveal their hole cards in any way until the hand is completed
First offense Warning
Second offense Ejection
14. If a card is revealed to one player it must be revealed to all players at the table
15. A flipped card on a deal automatically becomes the first burned card. The player for whom the card was intended will receive the last hole card dealt.
16. Two flipped cards on a deal constitutes a misdeal. The cards must be turned in and redealt.
17. Proper gaming etiquette and decorum is expected from all players. Inappropriate behavior like throwing cards may be punished with a penalty such as being dealt out for a length of time. A severe infraction such as abusive or disruptive behavior may be punished by eviction from the tournament.

18. Restroom breaks are to be taken on the player=s time. If player is absent during a hand blinds and antes (if applicable) will be paid. Regular breaks will be scheduled.
19. NO STRING BETS.
20. No splashing the pot.
21. One player per hand. You may not ask advice as to how to act during your action period.
22. Small blinds will move to the next seat position even if unoccupied. Big blinds will move to the next player even if unoccupied seats will be skipped. In the event a small blind moves to an unoccupied seat there will be no small blind for that hand.
23. When a player moves to a new table, he/she must wait until the blind passes their seat to begin play or, at the player=s option, pay the big blind to begin play immediately.
24. If a table is reseated and three of the players are new to the table, the players will deal the first Ace to determine the dealer immediately prior to resuming the session. At the start of the final table, the players will deal the first Ace to determine the dealer even if less than three of the players are new.
25. All final decisions will be made by the tournament director
